Kevin excused himself and went and talked to the Director of the group home. "O IT'S NOT SO BAD"

Patients getting a heightened sense of worry, doubt, fear, anxiety, despair, depression, suicidal and negative thoughts because of isolation,

Governor, I have news for you and all those who think it’s not so bad, you’re right it isn’t so bad, **FACT IS IT’S A THOUSAND TIMES WORSE!!!!!!**

I invite you to go visit any low-income nursing home, care center. or medical rehab and take a good hard look how coronavirus polices have turned these places of American healthcare into absolute houses of horror and mental torment. Then ask yourselves this one simple question, If

you or someone you love were forced to be in a place like that are you going to tell me that you would honestly look in their eyes and say,

“O it’s not so bad.” I THINK NOT!!!!!!

Our Elected Officials Scored an F in Protecting Our Rights and Freedoms

Our elected officials failed the American people by not protecting our rights and our freedoms during the Corona Virus pandemic. Here is your report card for upholding your sworn duties in protecting our rights and our freedoms of the Constitution of the United States of America.

For protecting our right to Free Assembly F

When the pandemic first hit the shores of our nation our elected officials should have sat down with Religious leaders and came up with a plan that protects our rights and our freedoms and yet places

precautions in places of worship such as Churches, Synagogues and Mosques. Places of worship could have provided masks and gloves and practice social distancing for all of its members. Places of worship could have had services outdoors while practicing social distancing, The fact is the human condition needs food for the body and it needs food for the soul. Shutting the doors of all places of worship without any debate or townhall meetings or inviting religious leaders to the table for discussion was the wrong thing to do and is not the way our system of government was meant to operate.

For protecting our right to open our places of business especially restaurants you scored an F

Our elected officials should have invited restaurant owners to the table and discussed the matter in order to come up with a fair solution such as all restaurants practice social distancing, all restaurants provide masks and disposable gloves, people were never given the option to eat in their cars or for restaurants to have tables placed outside spread neatly apart.

In protecting the rights of patients in American healthcare to be visited by their family members your grade is an F

Again America's healthcare providers and our elected officials did not sit down together in order to come up with a fair, compassionate, safe pathway to visitation in American healthcare. A plan that could have allowed at least one, healthy, screened, family member to come in and visit their loved ones at least two days a week for at least two hours a day. Family members could take the same precautions as staff members. Only patients who need hands on visits by family members so as to ensure a healthy state of mind and to ensure that the patient is receiving proper medical care. Any patient who requests a visit by their

family member should never be denied especially when confined to a hospital or nursing home etc.

In regards to protecting the patients right to have a member of the Clergy come in to visit for bed side prayer, counseling and to receive Last Rites our elected officials score an F

Our elected officials should have invited Healthcare Chaplains and Pastors to the table so as to hear the importance of having Spiritual support, guidance, encouragement, compassion and love in American healthcare. Most if not all nursing homes, care centers and medical rehabs do not have Chaplains on staff. These places rely on volunteers to come in and visit the patients, There was no provision in making sure that these vital services were not interrupted, Sadly we are all locked out and patients are being starved of attention, compassion and love.

America's rights and freedoms were trampled on all in the name of public safety, The Founding Fathers warned us time and time again against allowing such practices to accrue in America.

Lastly Our right to sit with our elected officials and the Department of Education in order to come up with a workable plan for homeschooling was tossed right out the window, The Department of Education did not give working families any resources such as instructional videos on how to keep a 6 year old sitting in front of a computer screen for hours at end and even though they get breaks it is very difficult to manage plus having to hold down a job. Our elected officials failed in providing the proper planning which should have included parents and grandparents sitting with the Department of Education in coming up with a plan that would be more effective for all parties involved.

Score F

I was too weak to tell them about the mistakes that my healthcare providers had made and now an infection caused by a contaminated IV had tragically gone septic and I began to fade away. At some point my family was notified that I might not make it through the night. My wife demanded to be let into the hospital to be by my side but her cries for compassion and love were flatly denied. My children and my wife called the Pastor of our Church, Pastor Wayne Basye and asked him if he could please go to be by my side and administer last rights but he too was flatly denied.

In total desperation my wife placed a call to the hospital Chaplain but his phone went to voice mail so my wife left him a desperate plea, then she gathered my family together, they all held hands in a circle and started to pray,

“O Lord please watch over Daddy, please O Lord help him to get through the night, please Lord help heal our poor father with Your Heavenly Light.”

My poor wife has not been by my side in over eight months now, I ask all of you how would you feel being on lockdown 24-7? compassion, encouragement, and comforts from home. We provide the protection and love that they so desperately need so that when they cry for help their cries for help are quickly answered.
