Mathew Chapter 7:21-23 Lord Lord

Mathew 7:21-23 “ Not everyone who says to Me, Lord, Lord shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven.

Many will say to Me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your Name, cast out demons in Your Name and done many wonders in Your Name? And I will declare to them, I never knew you, depart from Me you who practice lawlessness.”

For years I questioned this scripture verses, I couldn't understand how a saved person could be rejected by Christ Yeshua as we see here and if they weren't saved then how could they do all of the things they did in the Name of the Lord?

The answers to my questions came very slowly over the past several years, then finally today February 10th 2020 I received a key piece to this puzzle by God.

As I was sitting with Pastor Ken and Dorothy at North Mountain Respiratory Care Center and Rehab Pastor Ken mentioned the Parable of the

10 Virgins so let's take a look and see what it says.

Mathew Chapter 25:1-13 Then the kingdom of heaven shall be likened to ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the bride-groom. Now 5 of them were wise and 5 were foolish. Those who were foolish took their lamps and took no oil with them, but the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps.

But while the bride-groom was delayed they all slumbered and slept. And at midnight a cry was heard: Behold the bride-groom is coming, go out to meet him! Then all those virgins arose and trimmed their lamps. And the foolish said to the wise, "Give us some of your oil for our lamps are going out."

But the wise answered and said, No least there should not be enough for us and you, but go rather to those who sell and buy for yourselves. And while they went to buy the bride-groom came and those who were ready went in with him to the wedding and the door was shut.

Afterword the other virgins came also saying, Lord, Lord, open to us. But he answered and said, Assuredly I say to you, I do not know you. Watch therefore for you do not know neither the day nor the hour in which the Son of Man is coming.

The oil in this parable represents the Holy Spirit, now if we look at Mathew 7:21-23 we see why Christ rejected those who came to Him saying, "Lord, Lord, it had nothing to do with works it as everything to do with being saved. As Pastor Charles pointed out in his sermon, our gifts from God are not what makes us saved only the indwelling Holy Spirit saves us. The people who came to Christ saying " Lord, Lord were not saved, yes they could still do all of the things they did in the Name of Jesus but without the Holy Spirit in them they were rejected by Christ Yeshua, Christ only recognizes those who are saved by the power of the indwelling Holy Spirit.

Notice the similarities in both scripture verses, "Lord, Lord," and "I do not know you." or " I never knew you." Christ only knows those who have accepted Him into their lives in genuine repentance and love and in so doing have received the Holy Spirit.

Our Light Affliction

2 Corinthians 4:17-18 4 Our light affliction which is but for a moment is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory while we do not look at the things which are seen for the things which are seen are temporary but the things that are not seen are eternal.

NKJ Study Bible 4:17 Working means producing or accomplishing. Afflictions produce glory but the glory is way out of proportion to the affliction. Trials are light and temporary compared to the eternal glory we will receive. (See Mark 10:30) Paul's focus on the future enabled him to properly assess problems and see how small they really were compared to their eternal results.

4:17 Look means to keep one's eye to consider or to contemplate. The noun form of the verb means goal. For example in Philippians 3:14 In order not to lose heart the believer needs to shift his or her focus from that which is seen to that which is not seen from temporary problems to the glorious eternal rewards he or she will receive.

2 Corinthians 4:17-18 John McArthur Bible Commentary. 4:17 Our light affliction for a moment. The Greek word for light means a weightless trifle and affliction refers to intense. From a human perspective Paul's own testimony lists a seemingly unbearable litany of suffering and persecutions he endured throughout his life yeah he viewed them as weightless and lasting for only a brief moment.
11:23-30

Eternal weight of glory. The Greek word for weight refers to a heavy mass for Paul the future glory he would experience with the Lord far outweighed any suffering he experienced in this world.

Romans 8:17-18 1 Peter 1:6-7 Paul understood that the greater the suffering the greater would be his eternal glory. 1 Peter 4:13

4:18 Things which are seen.... not seen.... Endurance is based on one's ability to look beyond the physical to the spiritual beyond the present to the future and beyond the visible to the invisible. Believers must look past what is temporary

what is perishable like the things of this world. Things not seen or eternal pursuing God, Christ Yeshua, The Holy Spirit and souls of men should consume the believer.

Our Light Affliction. Eternity is forever compared to the length of time we spend suffering here on earth it's so miniscule that it can't be measured provided we are spending eternity in Heaven God willing.

Try this comparison take a toothpick and poke your hand gently with it now reduce that moment of discomfort buy 1,000,000 degrees that still does not even come close to comparing the time suffering we have to deal with while on earth with the time not suffering while in Heaven. Heaven is forever and eternal life on earth is temporary and for a fleeting moment.

Eternity is forever and ever and ever and ever to the billionth degree when we reach Heaven God willing we will look back on all the suffering and pain that we had to deal with while we lived here on earth and praise God that it was for such a short time in our lives compared to the glory that we will receive in Heaven with Christ Yeshua one day in Christ Yeshua's Holy Name we pray... Amen

Eternity, if you took only one drop of water out of the ocean every 10,000 years until it was empty that still does not even come close to the amount of time spent in eternity. Life is temporal, Salvation is eternal, death is outside of time, eternity is like receiving all the time in the universe...

Paul Boasts About His Sufferings

¹⁶ I repeat: Let no one take me for a fool. But if you do, then tolerate me just as you would a fool, so that I may do a little boasting. ¹⁷ In this self-confident boasting I am not talking as the Lord would, but as a fool. ¹⁸ Since many are boasting in the way the world does, I too will boast. ¹⁹ You gladly put up with fools since you are so wise! ²⁰ In fact, you even put up with anyone who enslaves you or exploits you or takes advantage of you or puts on airs or slaps you in the face. ²¹ To my shame I admit that we were too weak for that!

Whatever anyone else dares to boast about—I am speaking as a fool—I also dare to boast about. ²² Are they Hebrews? So am I. Are they Israelites? So am I. Are they Abraham’s descendants? So am I. ²³ Are they servants of Christ? (I am out of my mind to talk like this.) I am more. I have worked much harder, been in prison more frequently, been flogged more severely, and been exposed to death again and again. ²⁴ Five times I received from the Jews the forty lashes minus one. ²⁵ Three times I was beaten with rods, once I was pelted with stones, three times I was shipwrecked, I spent a night and a day in the open sea, ²⁶ I have been constantly on the move. I have been in danger from rivers, in danger from bandits, in danger from my fellow Jews, in danger from Gentiles; in danger in the city, in danger in the country, in danger at sea; and in danger from false believers. ²⁷ I have labored and toiled and have often gone without sleep; I have known hunger and thirst and have often gone without food; I have been cold and naked. ²⁸ Besides everything else, I face daily the pressure of my concern for all the churches. ²⁹ Who is weak, and I do not feel weak? Who is led into sin, and I do not inwardly burn?

³⁰ If I must boast, I will boast of the things that show my weakness. ³¹ The God and Father of the Lord Yeshua, Who is to be praised forever, knows that I am not lying. ³² In Damascus the governor under King Aretas had the city of the Damascenes guarded in order to arrest me. ³³ But I was lowered in a basket from a window in the wall and slipped through his hands.

I honestly don't know when I'll go home, I have family but the sad fact is they never visit at all. I try calling them but they never answer the phone. I even write letters to them but they never write me back. Thank God there are kind volunteers that come in and visit us and the Chaplain here is very cool. He sees us all the time. The Chaplain has a way of lifting us up that really helps us to get through the day.

By now you all must be thinking that I am a prison inmate well not exactly. You see I am a nursing home patient and the conditions here are just as bad or even worse. Don't let me get started about the food that's served in this place as an ex-inmate myself I will tell you that the food in prison was better most of the time, I mean a pancake is a pancake, right?

Well it's about time for me to go, I got a whole lot of nothing to do, I guess I'll read the Word of God that always seems to help me get through the day. Please pray for all those who are suffering in hospitals, nursing homes, care centers and medical rehabs. Please pray for their safety, good health, and that the Doctors, nurses and staff members will treat them with kindness, compassion and love.

Please consider volunteering in one of these places in being a blessing to someone who is all alone and suffering. Contact the Activities Director at any health care facility and they will be happy to show you the way. believe me there are plenty of things one can do from home in helping those who suffer in these places. 2am. I'm awakened by the sounds of nurses and Dr.s trying to revive Pastor Frank, They transfer him to a gurney and quickly rush him out and to an awaiting ambulance out front. Now reality sets in real fast, I begin to cry and pray, you see I've known Frank since our high school days back at P.V.

“Father God I need you here Lord, I pray for Your healing touch, please grant

Frank peace and heal his body, I pray for his family and mine. Please Lord grant us peace of a sound mind, body and soul, comfort us Lord and help me to cope with all this, Please O Lord take me home to my family in Yeshua's name I pray...Amen”

USE IT OR LOSE IT

Matthew 16:24-26 Then Yeshua said to his disciples, "If anyone desires to come after Me let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow Me for whoever desires to save his life will lose it but whoever loses his life for My sake will find it. For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world and loses his own soul or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?"

9:23 Take up his cross daily. To follow Christ Yeshua requires self-denial, complete dedication, and willing obedience. Luke emphasizes continued action and "daily" is not mentioned explicitly in the parallel accounts. Disciples from Galilee knew what the cross meant for hundreds of men had been executed by this means in their region.

Whoever loses his life for Me. A saying of Yeshua found in all four gospels and in two gospels more than once no other saying of Yeshua is given such emphasis.

Deny himself. Cease to make self the object of one's life meaning the object of one's life and actions. Take up his cross. The picture is of someone already condemned required to carry the beam of his own cross to the place of execution. Cross bearing includes a willingness to suffer and die for the Lord's sake. Follow Me implying that His own death would be by crucifixion.

Save his life. Physical life may be saved by denying Yeshua but eternal life will be lost. Loses his life. Conversely discipleship may result in the loss of physical life but that loss is insignificant when compared to gaining eternal life. NKJ Study Bible.

These scripture verses exemplify the term, placing Service Above Self for the glory of God. If we are focused only on ourselves we will lose our life to selfishness, pride, ego, and self of the flesh. But when we give our lives to Christ and we place Service Above Self in reaching out in helping others for the glory of God then an amazing thing happens we actually find our true selves, we find life and life more abundantly through Christ Yeshua our Lord. We find life through serving Him in obedience, compassion, kindness and love...Amen

John 10:10 The thief does not come except to steal and to kill and destroy I have come that they may have life and that they may have it more abundantly.

WHAT'S HAPPENING

We have reached a point in America where most people today do not know what their civil rights are or what their civil liberties are or how to defend them or exercise them. The end result is we are being taken advantage of by the powers that be every day.

After engaging my elected officials for months I have come to the sad conclusion that most of our elected officials do not know either. When the Covid19 recommendations come out from the CDC everyone fell in line like dominos in a very long line, and we went right along for the ride believing that our elected officials had our best interests to heart.

We have now reached a point in American history where if our elected officials don't tell then we don't know and if most of our elected officials do not even know in the first place then we all really don't know.

We as a nation have got to take the time to learn our civil rights and our civil liberties and how we can best defend them and exercise them for all our sake. How do we exercise our rights? By learning who to contact when our civil rights and our civil liberties are violated.

Here is a prime example of how this process works. I was locked out of the healthcare facility where I serve as a Community Chaplain, at first I did what every one else did, I did what I was told without question but as time passed I soon realized that something was radically wrong. I began making phone calls seeking answers. I called the healthcare provider where I serve and the Director told me that these rulings came from the corporate office so I called the corporate office and I talked to the Health and Human Services Director who told me that the Covid19 guidelines came from the Governor so I called the Governor's office and they informed me that these rulings came from the CDC so I called the CDC and guess what they told me that the Covid19 Guidelines were only guidelines and not law, imagine that.

So all of the health care providers who denied visits by members of Clergy and by at least one healthy screened family member who takes the same precautions as staff broke state and federal civil rights laws.

As time went by I continued to engage my elected officials at one point I talked to a State Senator who chaired the Governor's task force on Arizona Long Term Care Visitation and she had no idea that Clergy was locked out. I gave her my recommendations and praise God they were added into the CMS guidelines which now allow all Members of Clergy in to go visit without any limitations, also family members are now able to assign one or two Designated Essential Visitors to go in and be by their loved ones side provided they abide with the healthcare provider's visitation rules of safety.

As soon as I had the CMS Guidelines in my hand I contacted the health care provider where I serve I left a message, I called twice, then I called their corporate headquarters explained to the woman that answered the call that I had the CMS Guidelines in my hand and that if I did not hear back from the Director that on Monday I was going to go down to the healthcare provider where I serve and if they did not let me in I was going to file a complaint with the Arizona Long Term Care Licensing Department at which point a Surveyor would be sent out to the

facility to explain to them that they are not in compliance and if they still refused to allow me in to see the patients then they would be heavily fined.

The Director called me back the same day and we worked out a visitation plan that is safe and fair for all parties involved Pastor Ken and I will be returning to the facility where we serve Christ Yeshua in bringing the compassion and the love of Christ to the patients, staff members and family members for the glory of God.

If I did not take the time to ask questions or investigate these matters or in realizing that my and the patient's civil rights were violated and gather the necessary documents to defend my rights we would still be locked out for lack of knowledge and wisdom.

Our rights and our freedoms are extremely valuable otherwise the powers that be wouldn't be trying to take them away from us all the time. The powers that be know that if they can keep us ignorant of what our rights and our freedoms are then they could take full advantage of us without a fight. Know what your civil rights are and know what your civil liberties are, learn how to defend them and how to exercise them they were given to us through the shedding of much blood, sweat and many tears and it's a shame that we have come to a point in American history where we do not have the respect or gratitude in taking the time to learn what our rights are or how to exercise them or defend them.

It all boils down to this,

LEARN THEM, USE THEM, DEFEND THEM, OR LOSE THEM, ITS THAT SIMPLE.
